The Power of Words (Session #3)

I. **Words are a gift. They are a gift (a blessing), or a curse.**

"Watch the way you talk. Let nothing foul or dirty come out of your mouth. Say only what helps, **each word a gift.**" (Ephesians 4:29)

C. Mary Magdalene, who had a past. She had 7 demons cast out of her. **"Go and tell!"**

D. What is your fear, doubt, or excuse about God using you to speak and write?
